### FAT32 Issues

- Cache not working
- Intaller's placement of directives in Config.sys
- Chkdsk doesn't return correct error code.
- PMChkdsk hang
- Exclude drives from cache
- Compiler optimizations



#### Cache

- Cache was turned off in Netlabs revision 136.
- AN version is based on Netlabs revision 360 plus some later code.
- Data Segments and the Watcom compiler
- Benchmark shows
  - Hard disk no cache 750 kb/sec with cache 3000 kb/sec
  - Thumb drive no cache 65 kb/sec with cache 2000 kb/sec
- It traps on some systems under load

#### Installer Issues

- On clean install IFS statement incorrectly placed at bottom of config.sys
  - Fortunately this was a typo in the wis file easily fixed
  - Telling it what line to follow is more problematic
- Uninstalling the Netlabs version
  - On uninstall \os2 is removed from PATH and \os2\dll is removed from LIBPATH



### Chkdsk Issues

- Chkdsk doesn't fix mismatched FATs
  - However it returned 0 after the error
    - Result AN removables would report the drive mounted successfully
  - Now it returns 4 as it always should have
    - Result AN Removables returns an error
  - Unfortunately PMChkdsk ignores all this and seems to hang forever when it happens.
    - Just close PMChkdsk and Chkdsk from command line to see the error.



#### Other Issues

- Excluding drives.
  - SSDs and Ram drives actually run slower with the cache.
  - -exclude:listofdriveletters
    - Doesn't work for removables
- Compiler options
  - Netlabs FAT32 built without optimizations
    - Still experimenting with various options.

## Must have update

- ACPI 3.23.10
  - Fixes an inter process communication issue on fast multiprocessor machines
    - Hang on switch to full screen
    - Hang on starting a video with an audio stream playing
    - Hangs related to Firefox and Seamonkey
    - Probably others
- ACPI 3.23.11
  - Allows ACPI to load and run on more systems.



### ArcaOS Install PreBoot menu

- If you aren't using an external USBDVD drive
  - Set USB CD drives to 0
  - USB Floppies
- If you have a driver trap
  - select edit config.sys and rem it out.
  - Alt-F2/F4 and verbose boot



## ArcaOS Install

- Peer Networking
  - Make sure you install Netbios or Netbios over TCP/IP
  - It can be used with Samba if you use Netbios
    - Port conflict with Netbios over TCP/IP
- USB 2 port verses controller



### ArcaOS Install

- AltBoot
- Install from USB stick
- DFSee disk image (1899 mb)
- Create from Mac, Windows, Linux or OS2
- AOSBOOT.CMD
  - Mount image run to install from HD volume



- Remove the drivers you don't need
  - PRINT01.SYS Parallel port
  - IBM1FLPY.ADD Floppy drives
  - USBPRT.SYS USB printer
  - FAT32.IFS/CACHEF32.EXE Fat 32
- Don't remove duplicate USB base drivers
  - USBXHCD.SYS
  - USBEHCD.SYS
  - USBUHCD.SYS
  - USBOHCD.SYS



- Protect only (No Dos or Win 3)
  - Network related V-drivers (and probably some others) are still install.
  - Dos.sys is still needed



- The Shell Game
  - I use 4OS2 as my build shell(OS2\_SHELL)
    - It has some problems with some VMREXX programs
    - ANPM install fails using it
    - ArcaMapper behaves badly with it.
    - It is not supported for Arca Noae drivers
    - It is easy to change back to CMD when I need to
    - We have the source so we can fix things

### **40S2**

- ⇒ SET DIRCMD=/v
- Aliases
- **⇒** 40S2.INI
- 4START.CMD
  - Options2.exe



- Command line switches
  - IFS=J:\OS2\BOOT\FAT32.IFS /CACHE:2048 /H
     /Q /AC:\* /LARGEFILES /EAS /FAT /EXFAT
    - /EAS is broken in the early .10 versions
    - Cache broken since .10 beta 7 still not working
  - BASEDEV=OS2AHCI.ADD /N /F
    - May speed drive access
- VIRTUALADDRESSLIMIT
  - 1024 3072



## MMRE and Injoy

- Very slow
- Lacks ReceiveChain
- A fix is in testing on the Injoy side
- Other MM drivers may have same problem



- DOS what do I change/add
  - DOS=LOW,NOUMB DOS=HIGH,UMB
    - Traps if DEVICE=H:\OS2\MDOS\VXMS.SYS /UMB is also set
  - Add VCOMPAT.SYS or V2GB.SYS

### Dos Video issues

- VVGA.SYS
  - /nodisplay /nowinbgnd /nowincmd /nowinnotify /dual /int10off /debug
- VSVGA.SYS /int10textgrfxsafe
  - May need: mode co80 cls in Autoexec.bat
    - VVGA switches plus /bgexec /int10restoremode /int10restoremods /int10restoreregs /int10restorebank /int10bgndvgamode /noint10restoremode /noint10restoremods /noint10restoreregs /noint10restorebank /noint10bgndvgamode /int10textgrfxsafe
- VXGA.SYS
  - Doesn't seem to be a valid driver



### Dos Video issues

- On some systems you can open a full screen session and then switch to a window
  - Some systems trap on opening full screen sessions of any kind.
    - Fixed with ACPI 3.23.10
- Problems with WinOS2 windowed session can sometimes be fixed by changing the "Video" setting for the WinOS2 sessions

### Mice

- Amouse vs Smouse
  - ThinkPads
- Multipt.exe
  - WPCONFIG.DLL



### A New Loader

- OS2LDR.CFG
  - Can create a RAM disk above the 4 gig limit
    - RAMDISK = HPFS Z:
    - RAMDISKNAME = RamDisk
    - Use for Temp directory
      - RUN=X:\OS@\CMD.EXE /C md Z:\temp
      - Set TEM=Z:\temp
      - Set TMP=z:\temp
  - Can limit memory use
    - MEMLIMIT = 512
    - Trap dumps



### Xcenter

- ISwitcher plugin or stand alone
  - Winlist if you use ISwitcher stand alone
- Remove unused plugins
  - XWLan
    - Only needed for WIFI.
    - Older versions don't unload when Xcenter is closed
    - Xcenter very slow in opening
    - Unlock rename restart desktop or reboot
  - Part of Desktop process
- Add to screen boarder



### ANXWP vs XWP

- Reboot to options
  - It works with Airboot but doesn't give a list of partitions
  - setboot /iba:"eCS-N"
- Turbo Folders
  - Changes the behavior of associations
  - Assoedit
    - http://hobbes.nmsu.edu/h-search.php? key=assoedit&pushbutton=Search
  - Settings Object



- There are two ways to restart the Samba shares
  - Use Netdrive's volume persistence (not Autostart)
    - Turn it on before mounting any drives
    - PersistentVolumeConfiguration = volumes.cfg
    - Unremark it in ?:\Programs\NDFS\ndctl.cfg
  - Autostart minimized on startup means a visible rectangular window with a throbber annoyingly on the screen.
  - Autostart generally manages to throw an error dialog about something failing to load
  - Don't use both

- Shares and/or Server not shown
  - Update the hosts file to list all the servers before starting ArcaMapper
    - Need to make sure server always has same IP address
  - Setup a local DNS
- When using 4OS2 it hangs on rescan
  - Kill the background samba process



- Advanced mount options
  - All options are selected by default
  - They are mutually exclusive
  - Their location is unintuitive
- Smb.conf
  - ArcaMapper doesn't load its setting from Smb.conf
  - It overwrites the existing Smb.conf if you save.
  - Verbose log files may quickly fill a volume



- Network Printing isn't supported
  - Use the smb printer port (install with Print Manager)
  - Smbprint.exe doesn't work with parallel port attached printers
    - You can use Print.exe (os2 utility)
      - However it doesn't delete the spooled files which will fill the drive
      - Scheduled cmd to delete these



## Highmem

- Mozilla apps, AOO and ClamAV
- Highmem.exe (included with AOO)
- Exehdr.exe (Installed with ArcaOS)
- Warnings about stability
- Why not everything?
- Memory not releases on close
  - Use turbos




## Hide floppy icons

- Drives folder properties
  - Include tab
    - Add
      - Attribute: Object Title
      - Comparison type: is equal to
      - Comparison value: Drive A
  - Repeat for drive B
- **⇒** FM/2
  - Add /AB %\* as command line parameters



## Clock Sync


- The correct time
- Daytime as a backend
- Can use to update your time zone settings





### **IFX**

- Cleans INI file handles
- Backup and restore
- Not a replacement for full featured INI cleaners/checkers





#### 00

- A text-mode utility for working with the WPS
- Use it at the commandline or in scripts to
  - open, locate, and list objects, get info about them, assign setup strings to them, and more.
- Can perform all of the WPS tasks that used to require REXX.
  - oo's alternatives are more powerful because they work with any object, not just files or folders.



### Gotcha!

- Screen capture utility
- Gotcha Quiet captures "Print Screen" keys
- Alt+Print Screen = settings
  - Screen/region/window/interior
  - Clipboard/file
  - Multiple capture formats
  - Auto name
  - Delay (allows opening a menu)
  - Initiate capture



### Gotcha!

- Ctrl + Print Screen = Capture to clipboard
- Print Screen/Shift + Print Screen = Capture to file
- Design questions
  - Should a command line switch be provide so Print Screen prints to printer?
  - Should the setting window automatically reopen after a manual screen capture?

- Popup




### Lucide

- Why does it take so long to fix my bug
  - Trap on opening large PDF
  - Problem is with Poppler not Lucide
  - Fix Poppler (and load issues with Lucide)
  - Poppler is updated as part of the fix
  - Update breaks Lucide
  - Update Lucide to compile with new Poppler
  - Poppler traps with FPU issue
  - I get paid nothing. The Poppler maintainer is dependent on your donations.
