#### How we view software releases

#### We do NOT:

- Release non-GA software as "GA"
- Include in a GA release third-party components listed as "beta"
- Rush new releases simply to be able to say "we have a new release"
- Subscribe to any kind of "Rapid Release Cycle" just to "bump version numbers"

## How we view software releases

#### We DO:

- Test our software very carefully
- Work to ensure that everything which can and should go into a specific release gets in there
- Strive for consistency in the user experience
- Place the quality (stability and performance) of ArcaOS above all other considerations
- Take our work very seriously

## Release terminology

- Major release Major version number (OS/2 Warp left off at 4.52, so ArcaOS started at 5.0)
- Significant point release Less than a major release, but more new features than bugfix release (5.1, 5.2)
- Bugfix or Maintenance release Minor fixes and enhancements ready for release (5.0.1, 5.0.2)

# Overview of anticipated ArcaOS versions (near-term)

- 5.0.4 due for release very soon (*really*)
- 5.0.5 highly likely (enhancement list for 5.1 is long)
- 5.1 next significant point release
- 5.1.n-n normal release cycle (fixes and minor enhancements)
- 5.2 future significant point release

## 5.0.4 Major points

- Installation-focused changes
- First update to the installation boot technology (memdisk) since 2011
- Should install on more hardware with nonstandard memory configurations
- Debut of system updater (in-place update of ArcaOS 5.0.x -> 5.0.4)
- Usual bundle of updated files (RPMs, WPIs, drivers, Samba, ANPM, etc.)

## 5.0.5 Proposal

- 5.1 will take significant time (9-12 months or more from the release of 5.0.4)
- 5.0.5 could release some ready-to-go fixes and enhancements while 5.1 work continues
- Possible items for inclusion in such a release (6-9 months from the release of 5.0.4) could include (if built, tested, and ready for GA)...

## 5.0.5 Proposal

- More preboot/installer enhancements
- USB 3, UEFI, NVMe
- MultiMac WLAN
- DTAudio (formerly, DTA)
- Initial NLVs (DE & ES)
- Updated Mozilla apps, utilities, games
- Qt5 and new Qt-based browser
- more...

- 5.1 will take significant time (9-12 months or more from the release of 5.0.4)

- Migrate facility (eCS 1.x, 2.x -> ArcaOS 5.1; possibly Warp 4 -> ArcaOS 5.1)
- Better hardware type selection in installer
- Additional installer tweaks and enhancements
- Locale fixes to bring this subsystem into the 21st century

- New audio driver
- SNAP support for Intel HD video
- Replacement for outdated IBM FTP
- New selective installers to replace Warp 4's Selective Install
- Credentials Manager
- Samba 4-based server
- New, rewritten ArcaMapper

- New, rewritten Printer Manager
- New desktop notebook Background page, with new capabilities and fixes for longoutstanding issues
- New desktop search utility (Recoll)
